What is tim?

tim is your ideal **companion** through everyday mobility. **tim** is available in **Central Styria**, as well as in **Graz** and **Linz**. You can find more details about Graz and Linz at tim-graz.at and tim-linz.at.

At every **tim** mobility node in Central Styria you will find at least one **e-carsharing vehicle**, a public **charging point**, parking spaces for bikes, and a **public transport stop** nearby. Furthermore, at some locations there is a connection to micro transit or public transport, as well as e-cargo bikes.

Where is tim?

What does tim have to offer?

With **tim** you can **book** and **use** your sharing vehicle quickly and easily. To do this, simply go to the booking platform and book the car/bike you want at the time you want it. This can also be done **spontaneously**, provided the car/bike is free at the time.

How can you register?

How much does tim cost?

At **tim**, you have the choice between three rates. **tim-Basis**, **tim-Flex** and **tim-Lastenrad** offer you the necessary individuality when choosing the **right rate**.
